NARRATIVE

1. A.O. On March 22, 2024, at approximately 11:48 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] in connection with a domestic battery incident. I was dressed in a full police uniform and operating a marked patrol vehicle. This report is being written as informational regarding a secondary incident. My BWC was activated during both incidents.

2. INV: Upon arriving at the location of the initial incident at [REDACTED] Officer Hall, Officer Swords, Sergeant DeCastro, and I made contact with Dovico Miles. Miles (Offender) in a domestic violence case. Miles, who was inside the residence at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] communicated through a window that he intended to call his mother while I kept an eye on the front door. Officer Hall engaged with the suspect through the window, but Miles promptly closed it. He then proceeded to the rear of his residence, shattered a sliding glass door, and fled south from the location of interest. I attempted to pursue him to the back of the residence, but he had already escaped with an unknown direction.

Then, the K-9 unit led by Corporal Walsh arrived at the location of the incident. We established an extended perimeter, and Corporal Walsh announced Miles using the GPD's POI vehicles. After the announcement, K-9 was deployed. I assisted Corporal Walsh and the K-9 as a secondary officer, prioritizing Cpl Walsh's safety. During our search in the vicinity of 3100 NW 13th Terrace, we discovered a sock, an ankle monitor, and a secondary electronic component of the ankle monitor, all of which we believed belonged to Miles. While at the 3131 NW 13th Street parking lot, we circled around to the rear of the building and proceeded around the secondary location. As we were moving to the back of the building at 3131 NW 13th Street, I heard Cpl. Walsh issued commands, "Let me see your hand," but received no response. I also commanded, "Let me see your hands" twice.

As Cpl Walsh and I gave commands to who later was identified as female and ID as [REDACTED], remained unresponsive to both the commands I heard from Cpl. Walsh and my own announcements. I made contact with [REDACTED] who due to the investigation process detained. I stay next to [REDACTED], listening and responding to some of her questions. [REDACTED] needed clarification about our presence and inquired about the situation. She adamantly denied hearing any police commands while we were on the opposite side of the fence. Additionally, [REDACTED] reported overhearing an unidentified male say, 'Come pick me up here because of that bitch.' However, she did not know the male's identity or whereabouts. EMS provided assistance to [REDACTED], who was subsequently transported to UF-Health ER with non-life-threatening injuries. On Saturday March 23, 2024 at approximately 0251 hours, I responded to the area of [REDACTED] in reference to a domestic violence suspect, Dovico Miles, who had fled the incident location when officers attempted to make contact with him (GPD CR 24-004470). I was advised that probable cause had been developed for felony domestic battery and that units had established a perimeter and believed to have Miles contained within it. Lt. Guyan approved the deployment of a canine to attempt to locate Miles. I utilized the PA systems of perimeter officers to deliver two rounds of canine warnings which were as follows: "This is the Gainesville Police Department Canine Unit, Dovico Miles, you are under arrest. Surrender now to the nearest police officer with your hands up and empty or a police dog will be sent in to find you, and he will bite you." No indications were given that Miles made any attempt to surrender.

I arrived on scene and deployed K-9 Stern in the area of NW 12th Ter and NW 32nd Avenue. Stern led me in a southbound direction on NW 12th Ter, past a single shoe in the roadway. He continued to the 3100 block of NW 12th Ter where he showed significant interest in and around the back yard of 3178 NW 12th Ter. Stern led me west, where he alerted at an electronic device that had the name Dovico Miles, on the screen. Stern then began indicating at a privacy fence by lifting his head and jumping upward. Officers Poveda and Gamble attempted to look over the fence with their flashlights but did not see anyone. There was a posted sign on the fence reading "Private Property, No Trespassing." The fence enclosed the backside of a strip-mall style business at 3131 NW 13th Street. Stern continued around the front of the building and again indicated at an electronic monitoring device, presumably belonging to Miles, which had been forcefully removed/damaged. As we continued along the front of the closed business, I noticed a gate between the buildings that was ajar. The gate led to the rear (east) of the closed businesses. Stern then began pulling north and toward a small patch of palm bushes. I caught a glimpse of black clothing which is what Miles had been described to be wearing, and I shouted "Dovico, show me your hands." I then repeated "Show me your hands." Ofc. Poveda also stated "Show me your hands." He then repeated "Show me your hands!"

In my experience, suspects fleeing law enforcement often conceal themselves in or around bushes. There were also no other physical indicators that any other person would be in the area (ie trash, clothing, shelter). I received no response and K9 Stern made physical contact with a person who I still could not fully see or identify until I moved closer and began pulling Stern backward.

I then realized that the person Stern had apprehended was not Dovico Miles. The person was a white female, later identified as [REDACTED]. I immediately removed Stern from his grip on [REDACTED] left calf and called for EMS to respond to assist her. I then removed Stern from the area as Officers Poveda and Gamble remained with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was transported to Shands Hospital (1600 SW Archer Rd). She was treated for lacerations to her left calf and a laceration to her left thumb. Photographs were taken of [REDACTED] injuries by Sgt. Hayes-Morrison. Ofc. Poveda photographed the location where [REDACTED] was contacted.
