CORRUPTION BY THREAT AGAINST PUBLIC SERVANT W/ THREAT OF HARM CRIMINAL MISCHIEF \$1000 OR MORE

ARREST WARRANT

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDAY

To all and singular the Sheriffs and Deputy Sheriffs of the State of Florida:

WHEREAS, complaint under oath was presented before me, the undersigned Judge of this Court this date alleging that James Alexander Dewar, in Alachua County, Florida, on or about March 26, 2024, did, in any attempt to influence the performance of any act or omission of an act or did cause or induce a public servant, to wit: City of Gainesville Mayor Harvey Ward to use or exert, or procure the use or exertion of, any influence upon or with any other public servant regarding any act or omission that James Alexander Dewar believed to be, or that the public servant represented as being, within the official discretion of the public servant, in violation of or in performance of a public duty and did threaten unlawful harm to the public servant or to any other person with whose welfare the public servant is interested, contrary to Section 838.021(3)(b), Florida Statutes. (L3) (FDLE #3118)

COUNT II: AND WHEREAS the complaint further alleged that James Alexander Dewar, in Alachua County, Florida, on or about March 26, 2024, did willfully and maliciously injure or damage by any means the real or personal property, to wit: glass doors or windows belonging to City Of Gainesville, and the damage to such property was \$1,000.00 or greater, or there was an interruption or impairment of a business operation or public communication, transportation, supply of water, gas or power, or other public service which cost \$1,000.00 or more in labor and supplies to restore, contrary to Section 806.13(1)(b)(3), Florida Statutes. (L2) [FDLE #2756]

WHEREAS, the Court finds from the facts alleged in said complaint that there is probable cause that said offense was committed and that said Defendant committed them.

NOW THEREFORE this is to Command you to arrest the said **James Alexander Dewar**, instanter, to be brought before the Court to be dealt with according to law.
