second language. The VIC is four years of age.

As described by WIT 1, the class of approximately 12 Pre-K students was participating in "Pokémon Yoga." The DEF had turned the computer monitor on her desk around and played the YouTube Video on that due to a malfunctioning TV in the classroom. As far as WIT1 could observe from her vantage point (she was seated in a chair among the group of children) the students were following along to the Youtube video. Most of the students were gathered in the open space in the center of the classroom.

The WIT 1 described that although she did not observe as the VIC did so, she soon learned that the VIC had crawled under a student table during the Pokémon Yoga activity. Notable the WIT was seated in a pre-K student chair at the very table that the student had crawled beneath however her attention was focused on the group in front of her and not specifically on the VIC. Regardless, the VIC's presence under the table was not such that the WIT's attention was turned to the VIC. The WIT 1 described that the VIC was quiet and not creating any disturbance for the class or creating any safety concern while under the table.

The WIT 1 described hearing a `blood-curdling scream` that caused her to turn toward the scream and observe as the DEF aggressively ripped the VIC out from under the table by nothing other than the 4 year old VIC`s left ear and then forcing him into a chair at the table. WIT 1 stated the VIC continued to scream and cry for several minutes all while holding his injured ear with his hand.

The WIT 1 recalled that even after the VIC stopped crying when she interacted with him he was visibly upset, holding his ear and pointing to the DEF. WIT 1 was greatly disturbed by the DEF's actions towards the VIC and immediately took several pictures of the VIC's injury to his ear with her cell phone. After taking the photos of VIC's ear WIT 1 left the classroom and reported the incident to school administration.

The WIT 1 said she observed the DEF being `rough` with the students and grabbing them aggressively by the arms/wrists over the course of the two days. The WIT 1 also saw the DEF roughly grab the VIC by the forearm the previous day; the first day of school.

After receiving the report by WIT 1, the school principal (WIT 2) removed the VIC from DEF's classroom and took him to the school nurse asking her to look the VIC over for any injuries, specifically to his head and face. The WIT 2 stated that when she asked VIC if he was OK he responded by saying "Play." The WIT 2 stated that this indicated to her that the VIC was not afraid to return to his classroom with the DEF and, accordingly, she sent him back to class. WIT 2 observed an injury to the VIC's ear and determined it was "old" and unrelated even though it was to the same ear that WIT 1 described the DEF as having pulled. There was an apparently new bruise on the VIC's right arm.

After the WIT 2 spoke to the VIC the DEF was questioned about the incident by the WIT 2. The DEF denied having pulled the VIC by his ear. Rather, the DEF told WIT 2 that the VIC was screaming underneath the table so she pulled him out by his arm, not his ear, but that he may have bumped his ear on the table on the way up. The DEF was counseled by WIT 2 about pulling the VIC by the arm and was allowed to remain and teach in the classroom.

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The WIT 2 reported the incident as told by WIT 1 to Human Resources and DCF. The report by WIT 2 adds that there was no injury to the VIC in spite of the fact that there was an injury to the VIC's ear and a bruise to the VIC's arm. WIT 2 was advised that the report would not be accepted by DCF based on the information provided.

WIT 2 met with the mother of the VIC after school. The meeting was not planned or scheduled but, rather, described as coincidental. WIT 2 told the VIC's mother that there was an incident involved the VIC in the classroom that day. However, WIT 2 only provided the VIC's mother with the DEF's account of the incident and failed to mention the WIT 1's report/statements. When Your Affiant (YA) inquired as to why WIT 2 failed to disclose to VIC's mother what WIT 1 had observed WIT 2 told YA that she did not believe she had to tell the VIC's mother what WIT 1 reported because DCF did not accept the report.

LEO and YA made contact with the involved parties the following day 08/14/24 and the DEF was still in the classroom teaching. LEO observed a bruise on the VIC's right forearm as well as a dark purple bruise on both the interior and exterior of the victim's ear. The VIC's left ear also had a small scratch on the interior. VIC's mother indicated that neither of those injuries were on the VIC when the VIC was dropped off to school on the morning of 08/13/2024.

The following day on 08/15/24, the child was forensically interviewed and disclosed that the DEF had both grabbed his arm causing his arm to hurt and also pulled his ear causing his ear to hurt. The VIC held his ear and twisted it to demonstrate what the DEF did to his ear. The forensic interview was both audio and video recorded.

The VIC also was examined medically by the child protection team (CPT) who observed red/purple small bruise on the VIC's right forearm, bruising on the interior and exterior of the VIC's ear and a small healing scratch on the inside of the left ear. CPT had positive findings for physical abuse.

YA did not have any explanation for why both WIT 1 and the VIC would lie about the incident. YA showed a photo of the VIC's injury to the DEF and she again denied YA asked the DEF if she thought it was appropriate to grab the VIC by the arm and she said changed her story to stay she

The VIC is young (four years of age), suffers from Autism, does not speak English as a first

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language and is new to the classroom environment. From WIT 1's account, it is clear the victim was not causing a disturbance or posing a risk to the safety and/or wellbeing of others in the class by being under the table. The VIC's behavior - the harmless act of relocating himself under a table during a Pokémon Yoga activity where all the students were spread across the classroom to obtain sufficient personal space - did not warrant any disciplinary action let alone the DEF's intentional physical abuse which caused a painful and visible injury to the VIC's ear. DEF had no rational basis or legitimate purpose to support physically removing the (~40 lbs) VIC from under the table using only the VIC's ear.

The DEF's identity was confirmed by her FL ID.
