NARRATIVE

1. AO: On Saturday 10/5/24, at approximately 1959hrs, while on uniformed patrol, I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to armed disturbance later re-verified domestic battery. I was in full uniform and driving a marked patrol vehicle.

2. INV: Upon arrival I made contact with Chester L. James (OF) who stated during a verbal argument with his girlfriend [REDACTED] she pulled out a knife and threatened to cut him. James stated that [REDACTED] was upset with him for wanting to leave their friend's house after drinking all day. James stated [REDACTED] cut him all over but there were no signs of injuries to his person. I had James stand-by with Ofc. Mills while I spoke [REDACTED].

 I spoke to [REDACTED] who stated that she and James have been drinking at their friend's house for most of the day and he became upset when she told him to go home without her. She stated during the argument James placed both hands around her neck, applying pressure, causing her to be unable to breathe properly, but she did not lose consciousness. [REDACTED] stated she broke free from James and hid in the bathroom until LEO arrived on scene.

- I spoke to [REDACTED] (WI) who stated him, James, and [REDACTED] were all sitting on the front porch drinking when James appeared to get upset for no reason a [REDACTED]. While both parties were arguing, [REDACTED] saw James grabbed [REDACTED] around the neck area trying to force her to leave the house. Richard stated [REDACTED] broke free and ran into the house until LEO arrived on scene. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] never had a knife during the physical altercation and only ran away from James.

- I returned to James and Ofc. Jin read him his Miranda Rights from his GPD issued card. Post Miranda when I questioned James why he did not have any injuries from the knife he claimed [REDACTED] used against him, he stated she has cut him in the past but must have missed him today. I asked James about the argument he had with [REDACTED] and he stated she started cursing him out because he was ready for them to go home. James denied choking [REDACTED] and that he only grabbed her by the shirt collar to force her to leave the house. I placed James in handcuffs, doubled checked for fit and locked. I searched James and transported him to ASO-DOJ without incident.

- Ofc. G. Meshes took photos of both parties with his GPD issued cellphone and uploaded them to evidence.com. Ofc. Mills completed LAP form and provided [REDACTED] with paperwork for the incidents.

3. EV: My BWC was activated during this investigation.

4. SCA: James was charged with domestic battery by strangulation.
