**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT CHRISTIAN VARGAS'
MOTION TO ALLOW OUT OF STATE TRAVEL**

THIS CAUSE having come for consideration on the filing by the Defendant, **CHRISTIAN VARGAS**, of his Unopposed Motion to Allow Out of State Travel, and the Court having been advised that the State of Florida does not object to the relief sought therein, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises. It is thereupon,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that **VARGAS'** Motion to Allow Out of State Travel be, and the same, is hereby **GRANTED** and that **VARGAS** is permitted to travel with his parents to New York, New York from November 29, 2024 until December 2, 2024. It is further, **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that **VARGAS'** curfew is extended until 11:00 P.M. on only December 2, 2024 to allow for return travel.
