Breakout Session

The board of the Children’s Trust of Alachua approved the following items to be funded during the 2024-2025 fiscal year.

The purpose of the breakout session was to gather comments on ideas for a supplemental proposal to the CTAC board to re-allocate the \$66,850, with the following results.

Comments on “Expand the Youth Steering Committee”

- Co-Responder Team for Juveniles -
- Law Enforcement (GPD/ASO) teamed up with a Social Worker/JPO/Case Assignment
- Assign at risk youth to the team
- Team only responds to juveniles and their family
- Provide resources to the family (not just juvenile)
- Family members (siblings are at risk) and this would provide mediation/immediate intervention efforts.
- Allocate a certain portion of funds outside of the county to specific areas - Newberry, etc.
- Learn more about what supports are needed for youth who are most closely impacted to be able to participate - is it a counselor, is it funds for childcare so they can attend regularly, transportation like bus passes - learn more from Cherie about what they specifically need and is there a way to build this in regularly.

Comments on “Tier 2 grant initiatives”

No comments received.

Comments on “Grants for programming around the laptop carts”

Still need more information on this, but generally think it is a good plan, as long as it focuses on schools, research, etc. Needs good monitoring and programming. Be able to keep students from getting into bad things.

Comments on “Any other thoughts or ideas?”
