Program Updates

CTAC Proposal

During their September 23 meeting, the Children's Trust of Alachua County (CTAC) approved most of the alliance's proposal for project funding, except for \$66,850 requested for a grant manager and the alliance's administrative assistant. CTAC approved the supplemental request to re-allocated that amount at the November 4 CTAC meeting to be used for two additional Youth Steering Committees in Alachua County and to increase the amount of funding for grant-funded projects.

Violence Interruption

Caleb Young and Brittany Coleman presented the community's violence interruption work. They collected feedback from the community and held multiple town hall meetings as part of the IMPACT GNV initiative. The work focuses on using a public health perspective as a guidepost to create programs geared toward reducing gun violence. They also described the work of the BOLD Program and their efforts to establish more programs for our schools. There was a robust discussion with the participants that attended the meeting.
